

## Devotional

Hi wonderful Prayer Partners,

It is now only four weeks to Christmas. Our daughter is due to have her third baby any day. We are all very excited about having this precious new addition to our family with us for Christmas! We are trusting God for a safe birth of a healthy baby and his care for our daughter. Owen and I are on standby to come and mind their two children when 'things start happening'. We live about 15 minutes away but our daughter has another contingency plan in case the contractions come 'thick and fast'. Her sister in law lives about two minutes away. Bron and Phil would much prefer this baby to be born in the hospital where the trained medical staff and all the facilities are rather than at home or in the car on the way. They very much know that God is with them. How blessed are we by the medical people and facilities we have in this country!

This made me think of Joseph and Mary with the immanent birth of baby Jesus. Dr David Jeremiah in his Turning Points magazine and devotional says "As the crow flies, it is about 110 km from Nazareth to Bethlehem. This trip would have been more like 160km for this couple due to the route they needed to take. If they travelled an average of 2kms per hour it would have taken them 50 travelling hours to walk 160km. If they travelled an average of 8 hours per day, it would have taken 6.25 days to walk from Nazareth to Bethlehem. So roughly 1 week, one way—2 weeks round trip - on foot and by donkey." Imagine how they must have felt to be told on arrival in Bethlehem that there was no room left in any inn for the birth of this baby.

However they knew that God was with them which makes ALL the difference no matter what situation we are faced with. We, like Mary and Joseph, need to trust in God's faithfulness and goodness to us as we travel life's journey which can sometimes present considerable challenges but can also bring great blessings. Our hope is in Jesus Christ, Immanuel - God with us.

This PrayerForce is the last I'm doing as Prayer Co-ordinator as I finish my role this year. It has been such a privilege to undertake this role since 2007. I am so thankful to God for His guidance, love and blessings to me and of course his wonderful faithfulness in always answering our prayers in His very best way. My sincere thanks to everyone who is part of the MMM prayer network. Your prayers for the work and workers in MMM are invaluable and pleasing to God. I will continue to underpin MMM in prayer and look forward to keep connecting with my many special friends in MMM and hear what God is doing.


