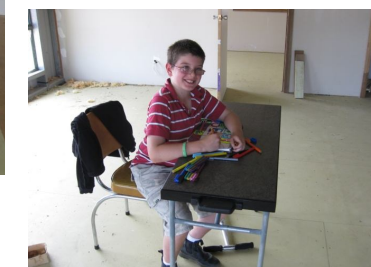
# MMM SA News
