## Nehemiah,

cup bearer to the Persian King Artaxerxes and was one of the most influential

court officials of his day. He was greatly burdened for his people when he heard that they were suffering in Jerusalem because they had no protection from their enemies. The broken walls that previously surrounded Jerusalem had afforded its inhabitants protection and security. Nehemiah could see that the rebuilding of the walls would free his people from the constant harassment of their enemies and enable them to worship the Lord without fear.

The rebuilding the wall was a seemingly impossible task to the people of Jerusalem, circumstances were just not favorable! Scripture also records the severe opposition from within and without the camp and the discouragement and fear that the people of Jerusalem experienced as they undertook the task of rebuilding the wall. Yet in spite of all this, under the leadership of Nehemiah they rebuilt the wall in just 52 days. Amazing isn't it!

While the people of Jerusalem certainly could not have done it without the work of the Lord, one other vital key to their success was that they worked together in unity to achieve things that they had not initially thought possible. Each clan and family took their place on the wall, working

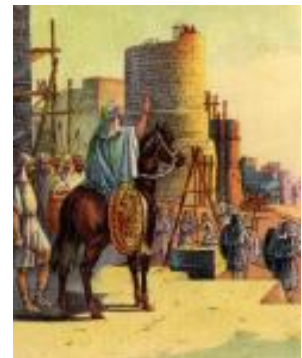
together and watching out for each other. (Nehemiah 3)

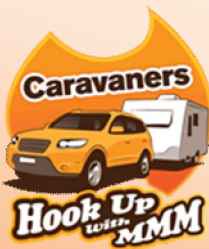

**South Africa The Kings School-** Glen Eden March to May.

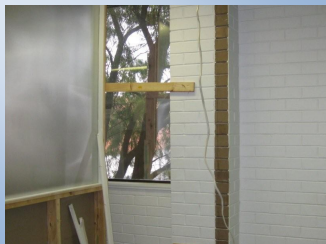
This Christian School caters for Children from pre-school age with a background of extreme poverty. Food and accommodation will be available, costs to and from South Africa would be about \$ 2500.00
