November 2009 Trip to Thailand

Our God is truly amazing.

We are going to post a quote from Max about what he and the team did while in Thailand. The project at Home of Hope was just one of the many things they managed to accomplish:

“..the most rewarding of all was to refurbish a children's home in Chiang Mai we were there for 4 days. We replaced over 85 different plumbing connections such as taps and water cocks and hand basin connections, Rebuilt 2 washing and preparation food tables (made of concrete and Tiles), and also rebuilt a new sink bench. The kitchen looked like new . Replaced 20 roof tiles (large corrugated fibro tiles) that had cracked and were letting in water. Painted the dining room and girls dormitory. There were many other things but it is suffice to say that when we had finished and prayed for the director of House of hope she said thanks with tears.”

Our time spent in Thailand with the WA team was truly a blessing, not only to us but those who we worked for. We would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your prayer support for us and the team whilst we were away.

It was great to have a young couple from WA join us as they spent time out from their overseas travel to come on the team and lend a hand, they were a great help and I know were blessed as they served the children and those working in the home.
