## We Need Your Help

Make generosity part of your growth strategy

Over many years we have had either project commitments or permanent expat staff stationed in Northern Thailand. When Max & Barb Smart were working on projects in Thailand they did significant research into a location for a permanent base for MMM operations there, eventually recommending the Chiang Rai province (*the most northern province in Thailand*).

Since that time we have had a base there where ex-pat staff including Max & Barb Smart, & Anthony & Siska Hocking as well as local Thai staff have worked from. We have occupied a rental property which on several occasions has changed hands and we have had the threat of losing the tenancy. A longer term vision has been needed to provide a permanent base where vehicles, tools, materials, and staff can reside.

In October 2016 CEO Terrence Baxter and Board members Shane Prior (*Chairman*) & Rod McGarvie visited the region and inspected a property that was open for sale, with the view of purchasing the property if it was available at the right price. After a healthy discussion the Board made the decision to purchase the property. Since then we have been seeking donations to raise the funds necessary for stage one of a three stage project, stage one being the land acquisition.

At the time of this TeamNews publication we have raised approximately 65% of the \$30,000 necessary. The appeal will remain open until all the funds have been received at which time we will proceed with the purchase of the property. ## Toronto Baptist Project

The first project for the year kicked off on the 15 January.

Five men, Paul Barnham, Barry Campbell, Phill Hall, Roelof Oosterveen and a newcomer, Ray Cannon, were involved in replacing the back hall floor at Toronto Baptist while its ministries were in recess.

The hall, with its Cyprus pine floor, had previously been relocated from Rathmines WW2 Seaplane Base back in the 1960's and attached to the back of the church. The floor had deteriorated over the years through continued use. This was gradually pulled up and replaced with 900m of secret-nailed tallow wood floor. This took 5 days of concentrated effort. The weather was kind with cooler days that week.

The floor was then sanded and polished by a contractor who "miraculously" due to a postponement of other work, was able to come at short notice.

Barry and Roelof fitted the skirting boards after the epoxy on the floor was hardened.



## Thailand Happenings

This year, we continue to be a blessing to ministries we assisted with buildings in the previous year. We helped put the exhausted fan in the boy's house kitchen for S2S, fixed a water pump for them as well. We also helped install water pipe and tap for YWAM base in Chiang Rai.

It continues to amaze me how important MMM's presence is in Thailand and how needed it is by local Christian ministries. We receive calls for help with projects small to


big as I mentioned above. Sometimes, Pedro will get a phone call late at night asking for help to fix something that has broken in a ministry!! That confirms me again and again that our presence in Thailand is crucial.

This reminds me of 1 Corinthians 12:12-17, it says "Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For we were all baptized by[c] one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. 14 Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.15 Now if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. 16 And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?"

MMM in Thailand is not a church or an orphanage caring for kids at risk or HIV positive children. We are a Christian organization helping churches and orphanages with buildings and fixing things. We work behind the scenes. Comparing MMM to a body, we are a part that is often overlooked as not important. As you can see,

to further God's kingdom, we are an important part of the body of Christ, we are needed.




## Prayer and Vision

**What's in a vision?** Well... that's an intriguing question that could take several volumes to bring some definitive clarity to. We are reminded in Proverbs 29:18 "where there is no vision the people live unrestrained, but happy is he who keeps the law".

In 1926 the advancement of 'wireless radio' was front and centre of an emerging society. Some viewed it as a fad, or novel toy for propeller heads. Others could see its potential in a limited way, but few could see the future like **Nikola Tesla** who is quoted as saying; *"When wireless is perfectly applied the whole earth will be converted into a huge brain, which in fact is, all things be particles of a real and rhythmic whole. We shall be able to communicate instantly irrespective of distance. Not only this but, through television and telephony we shall see and hear one another as perfectly as though we were face to face, despite intervening distances of thousands of miles, and the instruments through which we shall be able to do this will fit in our vest pockets."* Nicola Tesla was a man of great vision!

Throughout my life I've met and worked with many people, but few could really be described as 'a person of vision'. Vision is the ability to see what will be from what we have in front of us. Not only that but vision brings with it the pathway as to how to get from what we have in front of us to what will be. Some call it imagination, some call it dreaming, but God defines this as vision!

I remember a day when my Pastor asked me to look at a paint factory; I asked "what for?" He just looked at me and calmly said "for a church!" His vision was realised in its entirety 4 years later.

There are times when we pray when God places His vision in our hearts. Sometimes we can dismiss this as 'just a crazy thought' but if we truly explore these visions, grasp hold of what God is saying and pray through to the place where it begins to become reality we can see great things begin to happen. This is I believe the process by which God initiated the work of MMM. A seed becomes a vision, becomes a plan, which becomes reality.

It all starts with an attitude of prayer and a willingness to listen to God. Our faithful prayer warriors in MMM are the backbone of our Mission, without them we could not stand. Keep praying, keep seeking God's Vision for MMM and our work teams, keep supporting every aspect of our ministry in prayer. We need people of prayer and vision.
