EXTRAORDINARY TIMES

During January this year we were all getting over a wonderful Christmas/New Year period, getting used to writing a new date, planning for a busy year, and hearing news of a viral breakout beginning in Wuhan province in central China (*a place not many of us had ever heard of*). Wuhan is a vibrant city on the Yangtze river about 600km east of Shanghai, it is so strategically placed that it would be considered a transport hub to a large portion of eastern China.

> As we ventured into February we watched as this epidemic begin to have a major impact on life in this normally thriving city, and

then as Chinese New Year was approaching the gravity of the situation began to show through as they closed travel across China, quarantined an entire province into 95% lockdown, and began a social isolation program never seen on such a scale.

Who would have thought even then that this would impact the lives of everyone globally? For MMM Australia we cautiously considered the impacts as our leaders were briefed on the potential impacts, but life was continuing almost as normal until March 12th when the

World Health Organisation declared it a pandemic. The words Coronavirus and Covid-19 had entered our common vernacular. For MMM in Australia we needed to postpone all project work immediately the government advised, something we have never conceived possible in our 45 years of ministry. The world had changed and we were all trying to understand the impact of this insidious virus.

For myself as CEO and the MMM Australia Board we needed a calm considered approach that acted according to the directives being issued daily from our government leaders as well as ensuring the health and wellbeing of our staff and volunteers. These were uncharted journeys and the only


proper thing to follow was the directions from our leaders. Never before has it been so evident that we need to pray for all of our leaders in Government, to make wise and considered decisions for the benefit of all Australians.

The impact of social distancing and the attempts to stem the spread of the virus has been immediate and far reaching for MMM. A significant portion of our expected income was lost immediately, along with the schedule of fundraising activities that generate almost 1/3 of our income. Three major fundraising activities were post-poned from March, and we have no idea when these might be able to be rescheduled.

The Board has met several times using remote technology and the daily communication between our CEO and Board Chairman has highlighted the gravity of what MMM (along with just about every other charity in the NFP sector) is facing. More than ever we need our people to seek God and be open to His leading in the area of giving to support the ministry of MMM. The expenses of running a national Missions Agency continue even when no project activity is taking place. We will continue as a ministry because God is still in control, and at this time we need you to find in your hearts how you can help financially.



CONTINUEMMM Australia Projects

On March 24th the Board met to consider the evolving situation with the Covid-19 pandemic to specifically PE weigh up the government directives and how it would apply to MMM project activities.

The decision was made to postpone all project work until advised by the various governments and medical authorities that general community activities can recommence in some form. Several projects underway at the time were either completed or made safe and closed for the time being.

Normally we would produce a list of upcoming projects for people to consider, however until the situation is resolved and we can proceed with project planning all project activity is suspended.

As and when project work recommences we will be rescheduling two Papua New Guinea projects as soon as possible. We are continuing to plan the Build-A-Bond components for one of these PNG projects.



MMM Australia Board Report – 7 April 2020

It is only April and it is clear that the year 2020 will go down in Australia's history books as a tumultuous year. This will be a year that many of us will never forget. We started the year with the devastating bushfires that impacted many parts of Australia with 34 deaths and leaving many people homeless.

Then in late February we saw the Covid-19 Corona virus start to impact Australia. Since then we have all directly experienced continuous change to our lives as new rules and laws were introduced by our National, State & Territory leaders. These actions have been deemed necessary to reduce the physical and financial impact on Australians.

The consequences of this pandemic have already had a significant impact on MMM Australia operations. The MMM Board held an unscheduled meeting in March as the National, State & Territory governments started to rapidly introduce the current restrictions. The decision was made to suspend all project work and to ask our office staff to work from home where possible. Region Managers were also directed to postpone all planned fundraising events due to the social distancing requirements and banning of large gatherings.

These decisions have been necessary to comply with changes in laws but also to protect our volunteers, staff and those we work for. But it is also very important that MMM is seen by our communities to be compliant with these changing requirements. MMM cannot undertake its valuable work without our volunteers and as many of us have done a few miles it is important that we take particular care.

In times like these we can easily find ourselves dwelling on the negative aspects of the restrictions and the financial consequences for us individually, for our loved ones and also for MMM but it is good to remember that God has only good intentions for each of us. I am confident that He will provide and protect. Matt 6:30 reminds of His love for each of us.

Please continue to pray for God's protection over all our MMM volunteers and staff at this time and also that He will meet all of our financial needs. Also please pray for our Prime Minister and the National Cabinet as they make the decisions that will impact on the control of this pandemic.
