God provided a team of 14 enthusiastic souls who managed very humid conditions as rain continued throughout their stay.

Kempsey Presbyterian church is on the eastern side of the River and protected by a large flood levee. At the time of going to press we understand that Kempsey has

been largely saved from flooding by that levee. Praise the Lord.

We have many jobs to attend in the remainder of the year. We remain indebted to the many volunteers who are only too happy to serve those who serve. 
goes out to our supporters.

### Planning, Planning and More Planning




